Admissions Policy:

Windmill Pre-School is registered to receive Early Education Funding (EEF) for 3 & 4 year olds (and some 2 year olds). This means that any child attending pre-school from the term after their 3rd birthday (or their 2nd birthday if they are entitled to the funding) will be eligible for government funding, until they commence full-time primary education.

Additionally, Windmill Pre-School tries to offers non-funded spaces to children from the term after they turn 2 on a fee-paying basis. This depends on how many sessions are available after firstly admitting our funded children.

Eligibility for 3 & 4 year old funding: The dates determining eligibility of a child for free sessions are set down by the Government. They are:
