Safety first

The safety of our children is a priority. Our updated Safeguarding procedures officially records all accidents occurring in Pre-School as well as anything that may have happened outside Pre-School. Please advise staff of incidents occurring outside school resulting in injuries such as bumps to the head, cuts, bruises or visible marks i.e. rashes. The new Existing Injury Form you will be asked to complete allows us to monitor your child ensuring they remain well and prevent any delays in addressing the nature of an injury.

Feeling poorly?

- Please inform Pre-School by phone or email about any illness. It is a requirement by the council that we are aware of all absences especially for funded children.
- For the well-being of our other children and to meet correct reporting procedures, we need to be aware of any potentially infectious illnesses circulating. Please note absence due to sickness and/or diarrhoea requires a 48hr absence from school after the last bout of illness.

Keeping personal items safe

- Please take your child's bag home at the end of each school day session in order for us to keep the reception clean and tidy ready for the next school day.
- Please label belongings clearly. My Nametags provides machine washable child's labels. An order through My Nametags also means a donation to Pre-School. Simply ask a member of staff for an order form.
- We encourage children to leave special items like comforters/toys at home. If they need to bring it in, please put it in their drawer rather than bring it into the classroom. It is upsetting to see the children sad if their special things go missing.

Good Luck to our older children...

Its only 1 month until our older children are advised about their new primary school. In preparation for the step into Reception, our staff are teaching the children activities which they will find useful in their 1st year at "big school" from risk assessments to handwriting practice. It's a wonderful learning curve.

3 months into 2017 and there has definitely been a lot going on with even more planned. We will keep communicating through letters, emails and Facebook...
